- a committee of Directors and members who develop and review proposals for the growth and value of MEA membership and services.

OGRA MEMBER SERVICES COMMITTEE

- a committee of Directors and members who develop and review proposals for the growth and value of OGRA membership and services.

OGRA POLICY COMMITTEE

- a committee for the review and development of OGRA policies

TAC Monitoring Representative

- serves on a Transportation Advisory Committee monitoring TAC programs and directions

OCPA PRE-QUALIFICATION COMMITTEE

- MEA rep on the Ontario Concrete Pipe Association committee that reviews submissions for certification to make concrete pipe.

MTO CCIL –AGGREGATE- CERTIFICATION COMMITTEE

- a Ministry of Transportation and Canadian Council of Independent Laboratories working group that reviews laboratory submissions to meet aggregate specifications and gives out certifications for suppliers

MTO CCIL –ASPHALT- CERTIFICATION COMMITTEE

- a Ministry of Transportation and Canadian Council of Independent Laboratories working group that reviews laboratory submissions to meet asphalt specifications and gives out certifications for suppliers

ORCGA BOARD OF DIRECTORS

- MEA rep on the Ontario Region Common Ground Alliance steering committee overseeing the operations of the ORCGA

ONTARIO COALITION FOR SUSTAINABLE INFRASTRUCTURE

- a committee formed of the MEA, Ontario Good Roads Association, Ontario Waterworks Association, Ontario Public Works Association and the Water Environment Association of Ontario to lobby for greater infrastructure investment

ONTARIO ROADS COALITION (OGRA)

- MEA rep on an OGRA committee to lobby for improved standards for roads

- MEA committee to review and develop model access agreement for telecommunication companies working on municipal ROW

MOE committee to review operator certification needs

OPS ADVISORY COMMITTEE

OPS PRODUCT MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE

- responsible for the classification of products and managing product-related information in the interest of doing business with the transportation and public works infrastructure owners.

OPS STANDARDS MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE

- responsible to formulate and recommend policy to the OPS Steering committee and provides direction and coordination of the OPS Specialty committees.

OPS DRAINAGE COMMITTEE

- responsible for development and setting of standard drawings and specifications for materials and construction of sewer and drainage projects.

OPS ELECTRICAL COMMITTEE

- responsible for development and setting of standard drawings and specifications for materials and construction of electrical projects.

OPS ENVIRONMENTAL COMMITTEE

- responsible for development and setting of standard drawings and specifications to limit hazards and negative environmental impacts .

OPS GENERAL CONDITIONS COMMITTEE

- responsible for the review and revision of the OPS General Conditions specification, forms of agreement, and forms of tender related material.

OPS GRADING COMMITTEE

-responsible for development and setting of standard drawings and specifications for materials and construction of grading for road projects.

OPS PAVEMENT COMMITTEE

- responsible for development and setting of standard drawings and standard specifications for pavements and associated works for road projects

OPS STRUCTURES COMMITTEE

- responsible for development and setting of standard drawings and specifications for the construction of road structures.

OPS TRAFFIC SAFETY COMMITTEE

- responsible for development and setting of standard drawings and specifications for road safety devices.
