- Coordinate with consultants and internal and external stakeholders to ensure that project deliverables and schedules are met
- Follow corporate guidelines and best practices for project management, including the preparation of project charters, project management plans, project schedules and progress reports
- Provide specialized engineering input as required to internal stakeholders on stormwater related matters
- Provide engineering input and recommendations, as required, in the preparation of the Stormwater Business Plan and Budget
- Prepare written correspondence, corporate reports and presentations to internal and external clients, including residents, regulatory agencies and Mayor and Members of Council
